We had 45% return rate on questionnaires.

200 physicians and therapists are rated positive. 400 caregivers listed.

Kasier Permanente is considering how it could host the PPS education program. <u>But</u> <u>no need to wait</u>. If you are not satisfied with a physician or therapist, find one rated positive by another survivor(s) and talk to your HMO about switching. If you are on "straight medicare" or in a PPO, switching is as easy as picking up the phone and making an appointment with the new doc or PT. Later, you might want to switch to a doctor or therapist who attends *Continuing Education in PPS*.

Breathing and Sleep Symposium 2010

For the second year in a row The Salk Institute, with the monumental efforts of survivor Gladys Swensrud, hosted a day long program on the proper care for persons (mostly polio survivors) with neuromuscular respiratory impairments as well as offering Continuing Education credits for 34 Respiratory Therapists in attendance. Here are two of the many advocated guidelines:

1. **Annual Vital Testing** if survivors has indications of respiratory impairment.

2. This group of survivors, in particular, should have <u>surgeries done at a university</u> <u>hospital.</u>

Need a doctor or therapist recommended by another survivor?

The doctors and therapists whom our readers judged to be learning about PPS and/ or giving good care for PPS are listed by city. Cites are listed alphabetically. Please note that many physicians practice in two or more cities. Note that physicians affiliated with Kaiser have "Kaiser" next to their name. However, some of them see patients with original Medicare or other insurance. If you are in an HMO and need a polio caregiver in a particular specialty, you might want to show the list to a service representative and see if they have one of the listed docs or therapists under contract. Remember that no one is going to automatically make sure that you only get care from polio trained doctors and therapists. The survey results speak loud and clear. Polio survivors with PPS are getting some good care whether they have "straight Medicare", or are with Kaiser or another HMO. Our care will only get better if we continue to provide caregivers with information on PPS. And let's get them to the Continuing Education in PPS which we hope Kaiser will host. We have the challenge of leading Southern California to have quality PPS care **throughout** the largest and most densely populated state region in the USA. What we do for our own health will also mean that at least some of the 58,000 polio survivors in Southern California who are not part of our support groups will good polio care. This is have a good chance of getting a PPS diagnosis and a LA and Orange Counties' list with some cities to the north. The Southern California PPS Manager Newsletter is working on listing the positively rated providers in San Diego and the Inland Empire.

BLUE ZONE BLUES - TRAVELALERT

Question: While traveling in Britain this past summer, I parked my car in a Scottish parking garage and went to explore a nearby shopping area. Upon my return, I found a ticket for parking in a designated handicapped spot even though my California parking placard was prominently displayed. Officials told me that the placard was either a fake or not valid. I received a \$130 fine. If I did not pay, I would be taken to court. I had checked BEFORE I left the US and



was assured my placard would be honored. What else could /should I have done? B. Frame

Answer: When the LA Times contacted Visit-Britain on Mr. Frame's behalf, Katrina Sutton, a spokeswoman, said Scotland had offered to reimburse Mr. Frame for his parking fine. Britain's system allowing disabled parking in designated spots is called a BLUE BADGE SCHEME. The "badge" is recognized in European Union countries and some others as well. But there is NO RECIPROCITY in countries outside Europe to accept other designated "badges/placards", according to Brian Seaman a rep for **Tourism for All**, a British nonprofit that provides travel info and assistance to disabled travelers. He

also contacted the British Dept. for Transportation to see if regulations might be lifted in the run-up to the 2012 Olympics and Paralympics. He discovered that changes, if they occurred, would come slowly and may not be in time for those events. It took more than a dozen calls/emails to find out HOW one could get such a "badge" for European use. Seaman said travelers should make local arrangements to verify their placards would be accepted. That would be fairly onerous to do. He also noted the hassle this would cause for people touring around the country. Also check a rental car agency for assistance. When Lex Friedan, a wheelchair bound professor in Texas rents in Britain, the rental company has provided him with the needed documentation and placard. While this is a legal issue in Britain, government sources indicate that of the 2.5 million cardholders, as many as HALF may not truly need them, a phenomenon we also see here in the US. Perhaps the best advice comes from Scotland's publication on the Blue Badge (www.scotland.gov.uk/publications/2007/03/28155511/1 which states: "If in doubt at any time, you should check with the Local Authority." That is merely common sense and would keep anyone out of court.
